mission is to promote lifelong
learning by providing equitable
access to literacy programs,
quality literature and
educational resources to keiki
ages 0-5 and their caregivers.

On Children's Day, May 5, keiki had an opportunity to sit in on another special storytime hosted by Tamra & Mason Moriguchi. The event featured

books by two authors who were raised in Kapaia Valley. Jana Ogle is a children's book author and illustrator. She discovers inspiration in the seemingly ordinary, finding warmth and charm in sun-bleached drawings, childhood toys, and the comforting chaos of daily life. ## Koinobori Kaua'i 2024 Receives County of Kaua'i Grant

Kapaia Foundation is able to provide a unique cultural preservation project because of hard work by its members, support from the community, and a generous grant from the County of Kaua'i. After Koinobori season, damaged windsocks are set aside for the tedious task of repair. Unfortunately, many are beyond salvage. Each year, the \$1000 county grant is used, in part, to replace koi windsocks that are damaged by environmental factors during its month long display.
