Koinobori Kaua'i April 26-May 21

Due to unforeseen circumstances, Koinobori Kaua'i 2021 will be on display from April 26-May 21 rather than dates announced in last month's newsletter. Marking the 9th



year since its inception, 600 flying carp windsocks will once again dance in the wind throughout Kapaia Valley. Kapaia Foundation displays a koinobori for each person who, by simply living in Kapaia Village during its heyday in the 1930's, contributed to its rich history. These hardworking immigrants from China, Germany, Portugal, Japan, Austria, Korea, Puerto Rico and the Philippines came with a dream for a better life. With Koinobori Kaua'i, we celebrate their contribution to Hawaii's unique multicultural society and highlight the legacy that fulfilled their dream, the beautiful children of Hawaii.

Two work days are planned to prepare for the happy display. Volunteers are welcome and appreciated!

April 17, Saturday, 8am-12pm Clean grounds and pound pole stakes. Wear mask, comfortable clothes, covered shoes and gloves. Bring any tool you want to use....post pounder, weed wacker, chain saw, rake, lopper, sickle, etc. Lunch will be provided.

April 24, Saturday, 8am-12pm Raise koinobori and clean grounds. Wear mask, comfortable clothes and covered shoes. Koi raisers should bring a scissors. Grounds maintenance volunteers can bring any tool listed above. Lunch will be provided.
